Future Leaders – African Independent Research Fellowships (FLAIR) offer generous funding and support for your research in an African Institution.

FLAIR Fellowships

FLAIR fellowships are for talented African postdoctoral scientists who are in the early stages of their research career and have the potential to become leaders in their field.

Research proposals must address one or more of the UN Sustainable Development Goals. The fellowships will be based in a sub-Saharan African institution.

Each fellowship offers up to £150,000 per year, alongside a programme of support to develop fellows as independent research leaders including training and mentoring, and opportunities to network and develop international collaborations.

In addition to covering your salary, the funding can be used for research expenses, equipment, training and travel.
